Annual Report of Bethune College (2023- 2024)

12.2.2023-9.3.2024

With great pleasure, we present a brief report of the activities and achievements of the College during the session 2023-24. Established in 1879, Bethune College, affiliated to University of Calcutta, empowers students to become responsible citizens, who can go beyond academic degrees to make lasting contributions to society.

We are extremely happy and proud to state that the Peer Team from the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) visited Bethune College for the 3rd Cycle assessment on March 16-17, 2023 and after thorough assessment and evaluation we were awarded **an A+ grade, on March**, **21.** The NAAC team highlighted several strengths of Bethune College, including the close bond between teachers and students, an active alumni network, green campus initiatives, financial support programmes for students and the rich college archive. While appreciating the college's efforts, the peer team provided constructive feedback for further improvement. The college has been working on the recommendations for the benefit of students.

We are also happy to announce that we have secured **78th rank nationally in the College Category in the assessment by the National Institutional Ranking Framework (MHRD)** in 2023. Bethune College has participated in the NIRF rankings since 2019 and we have always featured in the top 100 colleges of the country. The college was chosen to host the State Level Workshop on NIRF Ranking Preparation at the College Level organised by the Department of Higher Education,Government of West Bengal on 13th September, 2023, where 121 participants from various colleges in and around Kolkata participated.

With a view towards sharing resources in an educational ecosystem, the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal has introduced the project 'Hubs of Learning through cluster approach' consisting of Schools and Higher Education Institutions' with horizontal and vertical integration. Bethune College has been selected as the Hub college in North Kolkata with 6 spoke colleges. A leadership workshop for HOIs of cluster schools and colleges, held at IIM, Joka was attended on 16th and 17th February. The college will organise a seminar on Summer Internship included in the CCF (2023) on April 1st, 2024 in which all spoke colleges have been invited.

Keeping in mind the recommendations of the NAAC Peer Team three new certificate courses were introduced in the last session. The Art & Craft Club, under Students' Activity Cell, launched a **Thirty-hour Certificate Course on Art & Craft in** collaboration with **PIDILITE Industries Limited.** This course for UG Semester 1 & 2 students which is free of cost encourages entrepreneurial skills in students. An agreement has been signed by the authorities concerned and this year 60 students have enrolled for the course. The Career Counselling Cell of the college started a **Thirty-** hour Communicative English Course for final year UG and PG students which is also free of cost. Around 80 students have enrolled for this course. The course has been initiated keeping in mind employability options for students and enhancing professional readiness skills.

On 03.05.2023 an agreement was signed between the NSS Units of Women's Christian College, Kolkata and Bethune College,

Kolkata to organize a 30 Hour Certificate Course in "Handicraft and Art Work" for the session 2022-23. The NSS Volunteers of the two colleges are eligible for the course. The focus of the course is on skill development and internship opportunities.

The college hostel which has been operational since November, 2022 now has around 85 boarders. In the last session, a bus service was started by the Higher Education Department to and from the hostel and college for the convenience of students. A net has been set up in the hostel courtyard for students' safety. Pipeline Gas Service has been installed in the Hostel. The college canteen has been renovated. A Digital board for measuring pollution level in the adjoining areas is being set up in the college campus by the West Bengal Pollution Control Board.

The most important stakeholders, our **students**, are worthy inheritors of the rich legacy of this college. A a painting of Chandramukhi Basu, one of the first two graduates and first Principal of Bethune College, by Sri Nirmalendu Mandal, was presented to the college by three illustrious former Principals, Prof. (Dr.) Pushpa Mishra, Prof.(Dr.) Manimala Das and Prof.(Dr.) Mamata Ray on 9th October, 2023.

The student strength this session combining the undergraduate and postgraduate streams is 1217. Our students have performed consistently well in all university examinations.

In the last session, **215** UG students secured CGPA over 6 in Humanities & Social Sciences and **133** UG students secured CGPA over 7 in Science subjects. Special mention must be made of 06 students in Humanities and Social Sciences who secured CGPA over 8 (02 from Philosophy, 02 from Psychology and 02 from Sanskrit). There were 06 students in Science securing CGPA above 9 (2 from Statistics, 02 from Mathematics and 01 from Botany and Zoology each).

PG results were equally good with as many as 44 students securing CGPA over 6 in their final semester.

Prestigious scholarships: We are glad that **10 students** in our Science departments are **INSPIRE** scholars [3(Physics)+ 4 (Maths) + 1(Statistics)+ 2 (Chemistry)].

Student Support

The college actively promotes the government schemes of Kanyashree, Swami Vivekananda Merit cum Means Scholarship and Student Credit Card.

The Kanyashree Committee successfully processed 29 applications of K2 scholarships.

243 fresh applications for **Swami Vivekananda Merit cum Means Scholarship** were forwarded and 229 more were renewed during this session. Besides applications for **Aikyashree** [18 (new), 11(renewed)], **OASIS scholarship** (61 students) have been processed. **4 new and 11 renewal applications have been processed** under National Scholarship Portal

Student Aid: Financially weaker students who fulfil the criterion for free studentship set by the Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal receive financial help from the Student Aid Fund run exclusively by the teachers and different Endowment Funds. In the previous session, 67 undergraduate and 5 postgraduate students benefitted from the college aid fund.

A 30 Hour-Certificate Course on **Ethics & Value Education**, for the undergraduate students of Semester 1 and 2 of Bethune College has been conducted since 2020, for creating awareness about social responsibilities and moral values, and practical applications of ethics in our everyday life.

A series of lectures and workshops were organised by the Ethics & Values Education Committee, including a day long Yoga workshop and Lectures on varied topics like Women's education, Gandhian Morality, Human Rights and Laboratory Ethics. The course was formally completed with Online MCQ test 8th October, 2023. 309 students out of an enrolment of 335 students appeared for the exam completing the course.

The Inaugural lecture of the session 2023-24, was delivered by Prof. (Dr.) Mamata Ray Chaudhuri, Former Principal, Bethune College, on 18th December, 2023. 391 students are enrolled this year. From 9-17th February, 2024, students, along with teachers, visited Raja Ram Mohan Roy Memorial museum situated in Rammohun Sarani as part of the course.

WEBEL: Since 2006-07 WBEIDC –WIL division in collaboration with Bethune College offers a 120 hours on-campus DIPLOMA course in Computer Application, at a very affordable rate.

The College **Library** has a rich collection of about 90, 238 books and journals. These include some rare and priceless books and journals. The Library also provides access to various scholarly journals through a subscription to Inflibnet. Recently the library has initiated the WEB-OPAC online catalogue browsing service, available through the institutional website.

- UG Admission for the session 2023-24 in 4-year B.A./ B.Sc. (with or without research) streams in the newly introduced CCF under the University of Calcutta were conducted online maintaining reservation criteria according to Government guidelines. A total number of 14,481 applications were received for 678 seats in 18 courses (B.A. 09. B.Sc. 09). Altogether 405 students completed their Registration process under the University. The entire process of Admission and Registration was conducted online.
- CAS files of 6 teachers (out of which 4 are for Associateship) have been processed in 2023-24 by the CAS Committee.
- At the administrative level, the non-teaching staff members offer unstinting support to meet the challenges of the college. **The Students' Section** provided wholehearted support in the digital processing of registration, examination and review related activities along with the various sub-committees and teachers. It was possible for the **Income Tax, Pay Fixation and Arrear sub committees** as well as other academic committees to process all administrative work owing to the full support and cooperation of the Office.

The Students' Activity Cell, along with the various Clubs conducted many activities throughout the year. A Thirty-hour Debate Workshop was organised by the Debate Club of the college for the Kanyashree girl students of Hooghly District in collaboration with the Office of the District Magistrate & Collector, Hooghly District, Govt of West Bengal. An agreement was signed by the Officer-in-charge, Bethune College, and the District Magistrate, District of Hooghly. The workshops were conducted by Ms Sanjukta Roy, Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science, Bethune College, and successfully completed by 40 students from 20 Government-run Girls' schools of District of Hooghly. This collaboration was a part of the Kanyashree-plus scheme of DPMU Hooghly who received Best District Award in this category on Kanyashree Dibas 14th August by Govt of West Bengal.

The Film & Drama Club under Students' Activity Cell organized a One-day Workshop on Introduction to Filmography on 6th May 2023. The workshop was conducted by Dr. Satyaki Roy, Professor, Department of Design & Media Technology Centre, IIT Kanpur. Almost 100 students attended this workshop. Students of the Drama Club won the Second Prize at the Radioplay Competition organised by St Xavier's College, (Autonomous) Kolkata, held on 4th March, 2024.

The Intra College Competitions were organised by the Students' Activity Cell and Bethune College Students' Committee on 1-2 December 2023. In all, 21 competitions were held. The Department of English was declared the "Champion Department" at the **Intra College Competitions**.

The **Career Counselling Cell** works actively in providing job opportunities and new avenues for employment.

Campus recruitment drive: The Cell organised Campus recruitment drives from various renowned organisations like Capgemini, LT Mindtree and TCS. **6 students were selected for employment** (TCS- 05, LT Mindtree-01).

Since most of our students opt for higher studies, the Cell organised **eight subject-specific webinars/seminars** in collaboration with the PG departments of **Botany, Bengali and Zoology** and UG departments of **Chemistry, Physics and Computer Science, Sanskrit and Philosophy,** where successful former students of the college addressed the juniors of their departments about future prospects of higher studies. Our ex-student of the department of **Economics**, Manjima Samaddar, an entrepreneur and awardee of the Indian Chamber of Commerce addressed students of all departments on the topic **"Gateway to Indian Institute of Management"** on 02.05.23.

In a pre-campus Career Counselling Webinar, Ananya Chatterjee, Territory Manager, SBI Life addressed the students regarding "Career Opportunities in SBI" 28.02.23. Another pre-campus seminar was conducted by TRUSTKLUB Consulting on 08.08.23.
