## ACTION TAKEN ON FEEDBACK 2021-22

The feedback received from the students, teachers and alumni was discussed in a meeting of the IQAC held in the presence of Officer-in-charge, NAAC & IQAC Coordinator on 06.09.2022. The quantitative analysis of the feedback received between15th and 24th August 2022 was discussed and the following measures were taken to address the issues reflected in the feedback and cater to the needs and expectations of the students.

- a) The long-standing demand for a College Hostel has finally been addressed. The Bethune College Girls' Hostel with a capacity of 150 inmates was inaugurated on 6th August 2022. The College Hostel has been made available to first year students, amounting to 50 during this session. Next session onwards, the seats will be gradually increased, to accommodate students of other batches as well.
- b) A new water dispenser will be installed near the Canteen and Vidyasagar Bhavan, to cater to the requirement of the students. It has been donated by Hon'ble MIC Dr. Shashi Panja and the work is likely to be completed by the next month.
- c) Since the students' feedback regarding the completion of syllabus was not entirely satisfactory, a department -wise analysis was conducted to identify the lacuna and this has been addressed through academic audit. Remedial classes and doubt-clearing sessions are being organized by the concerned departments.
- d) More books related to the CBCS curriculum will be purchased by the College library. The departments have been asked to select from a list of e-books circulated by the Librarian for that purpose and also prepare a list of recommended books.
- e) Mentoring of the Office staff will be conducted by a Committee comprising of teaching and nonteaching staff members to sensitize them regarding more student-friendly behaviour.
- f) A new classroom for PG programmes is being created on the first floor of the administrative building, out of verandah space. This is in response to a long-standing requirement of PG students.
- g) In view of the increasing mental health crises faced by students, Mental Health Awareness Programmes will be conducted in collaboration with Sayantani Adhikary Foundation
- h) A self-sustaining Ecosystem Aquarium would be installed in the Science Library for educational purpose and also as a part of the green initiatives.
- i) A new ramp is being constructed to consolidate the Divyangjan policy adopted by the College.
