An emergency meeting of the IQAC was held in order to decide the utilization of Fund donated by Sri Saktidas Roy.

Principal Madam appraised the members present that the College has received a cheque amount of Rs Five Lakhs donated by Sri Saktidas Roy in memory of Papiya (Dutta) Roy. This can be utilized to enhance the academic exposure of our students and will act as a source of encouragement towards their academic excellence.

To facilitate this the following resolutions for utilizing this fund were taken at the meeting.

- The amount of Rs 5 Lakh will be maintained in a fixed deposit account, Papiya (Dutta) Roy Memorial Prize fund. The interest earnings of this fixed deposit will go to the already existing Papiya (Dutta) Roy Trust and Endowment Fund on a half yearly basis.
- Papiya (Dutta) Roy Memorial Gold Medal for best academic performance in the Final University Exam in Social Science will be instituted and awarded out of 40 percent of the interest proceeds. This would involve the departments of Political Science, Economics, History, Philosophy, Psychology and Sociology
- Remaining 60 percent of the interest proceeds will be used to organize three Memorial lectures respectively in the departments of Women's Studies Centre/ Psychology, Economics and Philosophy each in alternate years.
- For each of these events, namely, the Annual prize Distribution Ceremony and the Annual Memorial lectures, Sri Roy shall be duly invited.
- A committee comprising of the HODs of the concerned departments and IQAC members shall be constituted to monitor the smooth execution of the process.
