- Portrayal of the concept
- Creativity and innovation
- Relevance to the topic
- Originality, neatness and visual appeal
- Overall impact

RULES:

- The topic will be provided on spot.
- Profanity, obscenity or explicit political content/controversial views of any kind will be penalised.
- Plagiarised content will lead to disqualification.
- The file should be renamed as: Name_Event. Each participant will be allowed one entry only.
- After the event ends, participants will be required to mail their entries at "bethunecollegestudentcommittee@gmail.com". The participant's name, department, semester and event name should be mentioned in the email. Each participant will be given 15 minutes to mail their entry. Submissions mailed after the given 15 minutes will not be accepted.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Choice of song
- Quality of singing
- Vocal range
- Overall impact

RULES:

- Participants are allowed sing a song of her choice, pertaining to Indian classical genre only.
- Participants must bring their own instruments (if required). It would not be provided by the organizers.
- Exceeding the time limit will be penalized .
- All participants must carry a valid student ID card (or some other valid college document) to confirm their registration.
- Students cannot participate in both Classical Music Competition and Light Music Competition.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Physical presentation (posture, gestures and delivery)
- Voice modulation
- Pronunciation of words
- Dramatic appropriateness
- Overall performance

RULES:

- Any form of poetry in English/Hindi/Bengali/Sanskrit is allowed.
- There is no specific theme.
- All forms of verbal/non-verbal expressions are welcome.
- Obscenity or vulgarity of any kind will lead to disqualification.
- Any form of explicit political content will also lead to disqualification.
- All participants must carry a valid student ID card (or some other valid college document) to confirm their registration.

RULES:

- Word limit: 300-350 words
- Participants may write in English, Hindi, Bengali or Sanskrit. Strict adherence to the language in which the prose/poetry is to be written, no words from any other language shall be used.
- The above four languages shall be judged separately and judged individually.
- Both prose and poetry are allowed.
- Stationeries (pen, pencil, etc.), including paper, are to be brought by the participants.
- Any form of profanity/vulgarity will be penalised.
- Use of electronic media will lead to disqualification.
- All participants must carry a valid student ID card (or some other valid college document) to confirm their registration.

- Participants may sing a single song or do a medley (combination of more than one song) of her choice, pertaining to eastern genre only (Rabindrasangeet, Nazrulgeeti, Folk song, Atulprasadi, Dwijendrageeti, Adhunik).
- Participants must bring their own instruments (if required). It would not be provided by the organizers. Songs must be in Bengali only.
- Exceeding the time limit will be penalized .
- All participants must carry a valid student ID card (or some other valid college document) to confirm their registration.
- Students cannot participate in both Classical Music Competition and Light Music Competition.
