Also, an informal departmental meeting was held where the matter was discussed and decision was taken to give more attention to student's need.

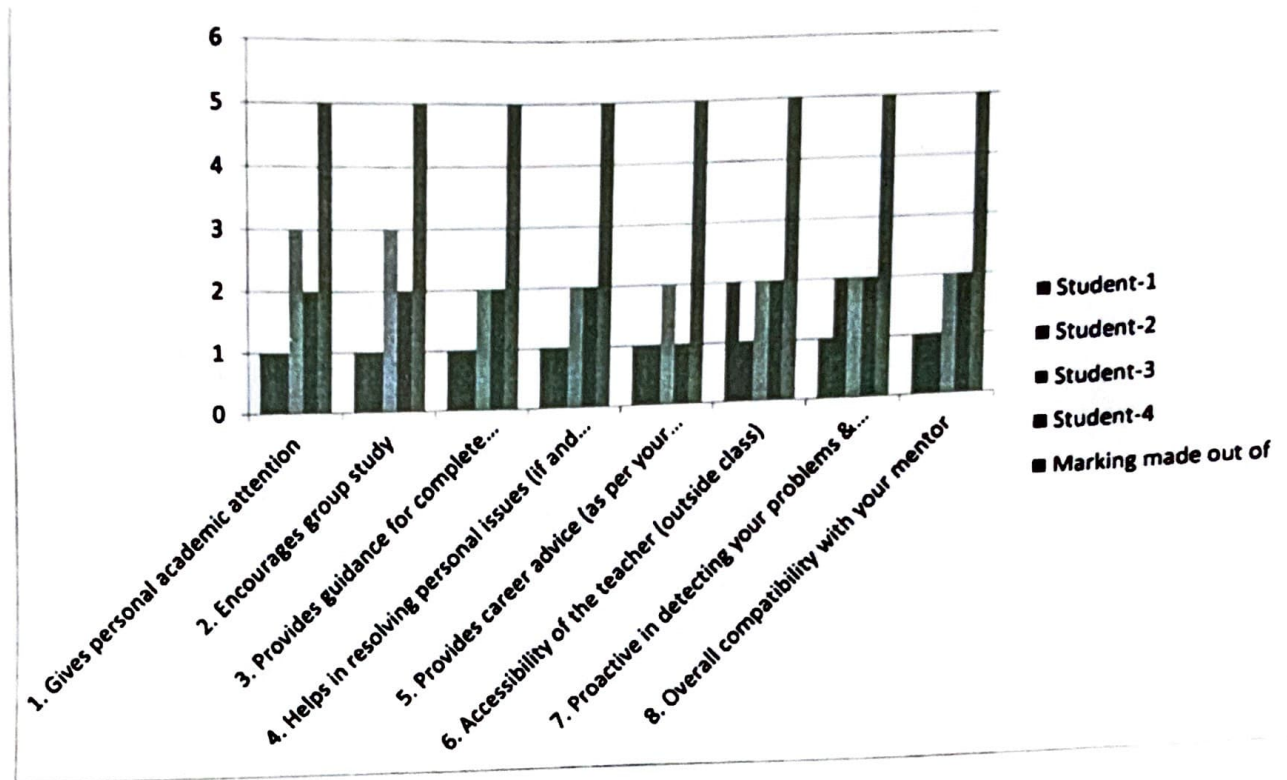

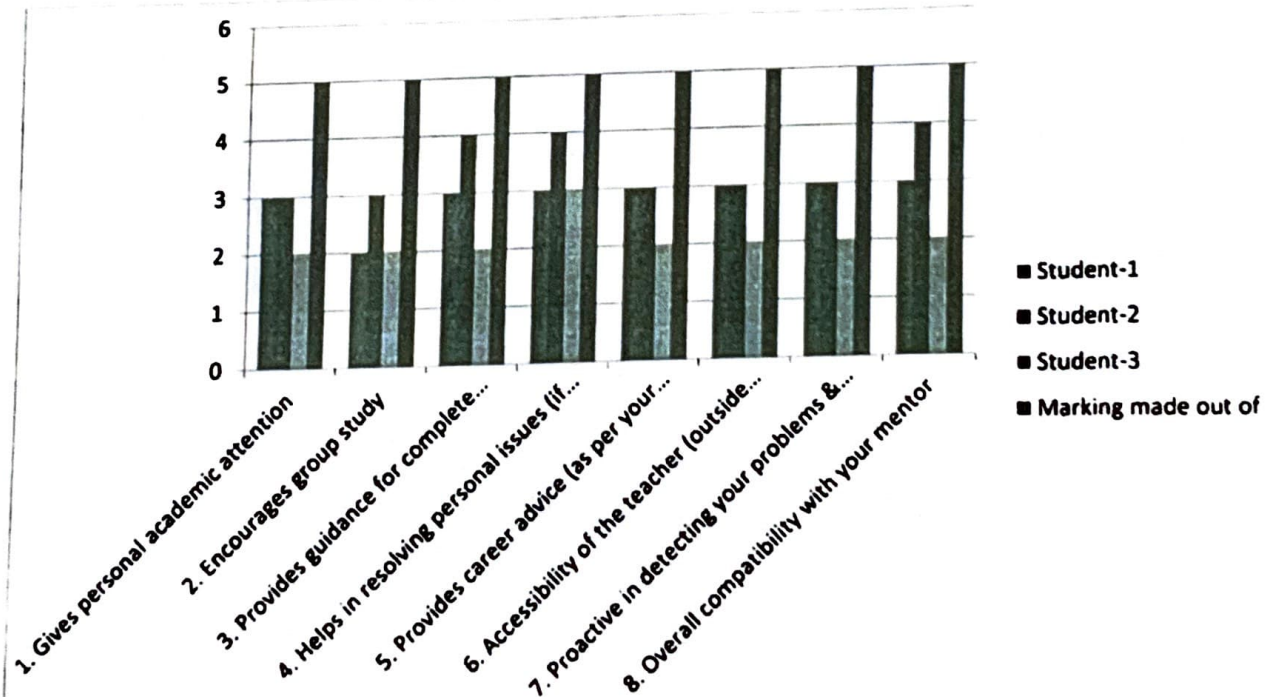

As per committee suggestion, both parties were requested to stabilise and resolve the issue internally and in front of the house. Mr. Heera asked for forgiveness from Mr. Saha with the assurance that such instances would be avoided in future.

During the same meeting, Mr. Heera talked about his pending medical bill of Rs. 40,000 for his wife's treatment. Dr. Kamal Kanti Shome has assured him regarding this. He requested that the head clerk look into the matter in house, and he agreed.







Sumita Mukhopadhyay, H.O.D, Bengali, narrated that she had been informed by the students about Paromita Ghosh's comment on Maroona Murmu's social media wall. She further stated that she was trolled and was bound to withdraw the comment that she had subsequently posted criticizing Paromita's post. She was also abused verbally.

Subarna Mustari, General Secretary, Bethune College Students Committee said that she had tried calling Paromita Ghosh but the latter did not respond. She added that students of the college have also been trolled when they had posted their comments against caste discrimination. She requested for more sensitization programmes and seminars through SC/ST Cell of the college where Dalit scholars can be invited as speakers. She further said that the Students of the college are repeatedly enquiring about the decision taken by Bethune College against Paromita.

Principal Madam wanted to know whether the teachers of the Bengali department had observed any behavioural aberrations in Paromita.

Sumita Mukhopadhyay stated that she has been found lying about certain issues previously and that Paromita had posted unethical comments on the social media previously. Otherwise she had not misbehaved with any teacher or student in the past. However, Paromita's parents had been informed previously about their daughter's behaviour.

Principal Madam said that she had a discussion with the vice Chancellor, University of Calcutta who has suggested that Mr Nilotpal Chatterjee, a legal Advisor of the University be consulted in this regard. Principal Madam further said that Honorable Minister has opined that the student has used the platform of social media. It does not fall under the purview of the college. She stated that in the view of Sukanta Acharya, the College can reproach but cannot bar a student from appearing in the examination.

Mr Nilotpal Chatterjee said no legal action can be taken against anyone for posting any matter on the Facebook. Posting of any issue in the social media falls under the Fundamental Right (Freedom of Expression) of the Constitution of India. However, Mr Chatterjee also stated that any kind of offense against Scheduled castes and Scheduled Tribes is an unbailable offense under The Schedule Castes and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, under section 3(1)(x). He further added that the victim will have to take a call. Bethune College can disapprove the act but cannot take any action against her.

Maitri Ghosh pointed out that media is continuously pressurizing the college authority for taking action against Paromita Ghosh. Mr Chatterjee replied by saying that the Principal is the face of Bethune College. She will not contact the victim or anyone whosoever. He suggested that a Censure Motion be written condemning the act. A copy of the same may be given to the Dept of Higher Education and University though it is not compulsory. He suggested that a sensitization programme must be done immediately pertaining to the need of the hour.

Principal Madam requested the Alumnae Association to write a censure motion to which Dr Minakshi Sinha, a respected member, Alumnae Association agreed.

Dr Kamal Kanti Som said that a SC/ST cell existed since a long time but no such complain has ever been received. Departments of Bengali and English were requested to write the censure motion.

Dr Sudeshna Mitra asked whether disciplinary committee should record this incident to which Principal Madam answered in affirmative.
