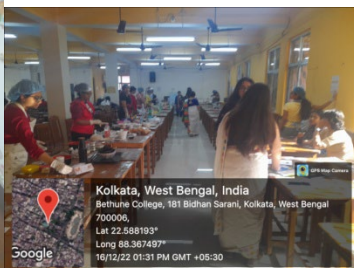
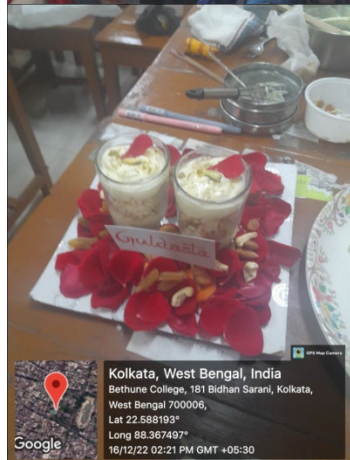
Report for AQAR 2022-23

Rehearse, Clean and Green

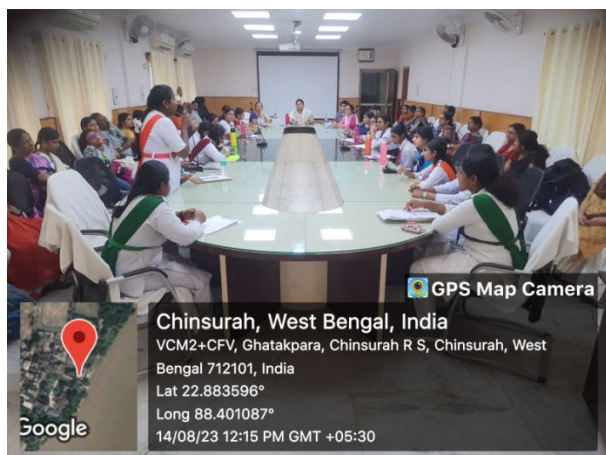
