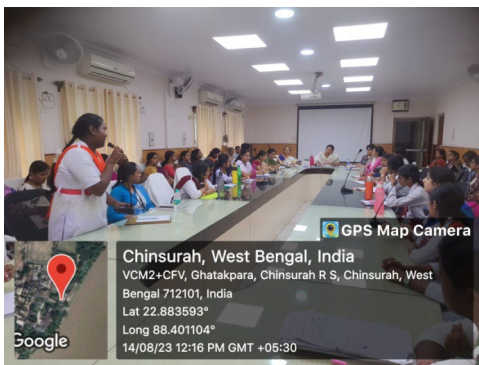
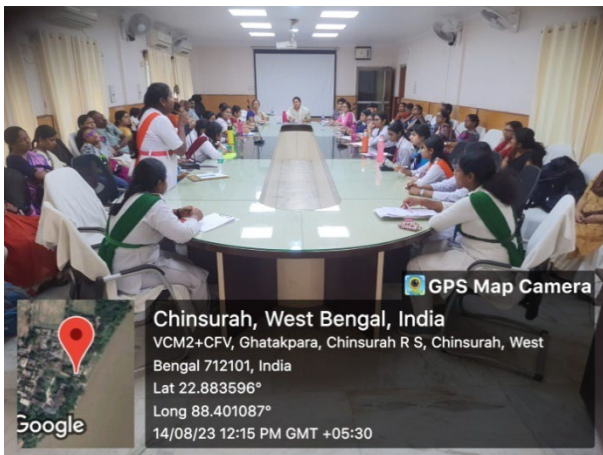


## Students' Activity Cell

### 1) Collaborative programme with agreement signed: **Thirty-hour Debate Workshop with the Office of the District Magistrate & Collector, Hooghly District, Govt of West Bengal.**

This year has been very prestigious for the Quiz & Debate Club, run by Students' Activity Cell. As an extension activity, a **Thirty-hour** Debate Workshop was organised by the Club, for the enrichment of knowledge and outlook of the Kanyashree girl students of Hooghly District. This was a joint collaborative endeavour with the Office of the District Magistrate & Collector, Hooghly District, Govt of West Bengal. 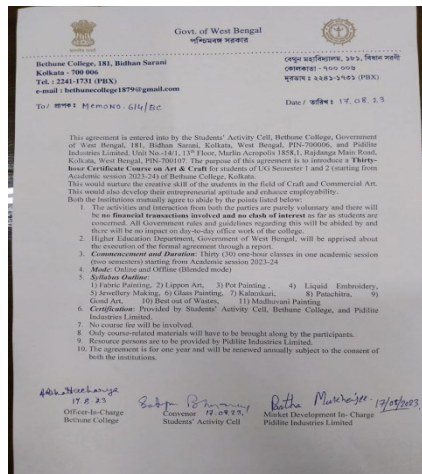
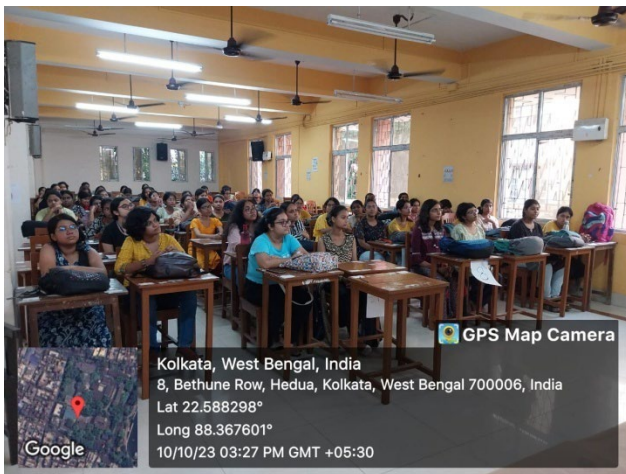


## 2) Collaborative programme with agreement signed: **Thirty-hour Certificate Course on Art & Craft with PIDILITE Industries Limited .**

Output: Employability and entrepreneurial skills of the participants:

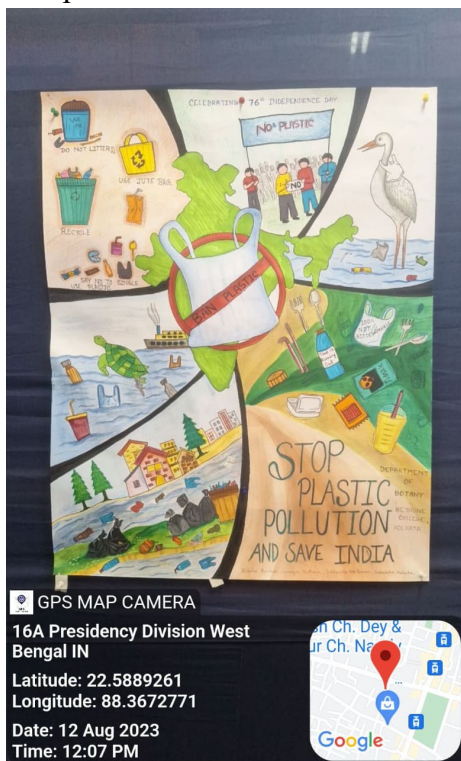
- 1) 02 of them have been appointed as trainers by **PIDILITE Industries Limited**.

The concluding ceremony was held at Dhanadhanya Auditorium in presence of Honourable Chief Minister which was attended by 30 selected students.

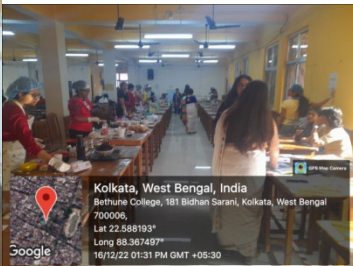
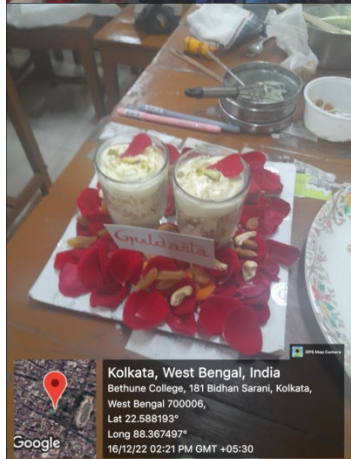




This year also the Students' Committee was formed as well as students' clubs were formed for the academic year 22-23.
